administrative work of the institution.


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- 7. The institution focuses on the development of the society as a whole and implements altruistic initiatives for the betterment of the society.
- 8. The College should frame policies for its proper functioning.
- 9. Qualified faculty members with good experience and sincerity are the valuable asset of the institution.
- 10. Students are informed of all the scholarships that they can avail and the management actively helps in securing the scholarships for the eligible students.
- 11. A computerized library with adequate number of well catalogued books and elearning resources are one of the hallmarks of the institution.
- 12. Faculties used different teaching methods besides the chalk and lecture methods. They actively used interactive, computer assisted, experiential, participative, peer learning methods.
- 13. Faculties showed keen interest in improving their skill through attending orientation, refresher and short term courses. In addition to this a deep enthusiasm was observed by attendance in seminars of their respective discipline.
- 14. Tutorial, remedial and continuous internal evaluations on a regular basis augments the academic calibre of the students.
- 15. Effective teaching plan was maintained by the faculties. Proper mentoring measures are adopted by the faculties.
- 16. Students were given ample opportunities for extracurricular and extension activities.
- 17. Students feed back is collected by the department analysed the scores and suggestions, and necessary corrective measures were directed to the faculties.
- 18. Feedback from various stakeholders were collected and necessary changes and suggestion were implemented.
- 19. Department compares the present achievements with the previous one, which is an appreciable approach.
- 20. The regular publishing of international peer reviewed ISSN journal "Star Research Reach" is remarkable.

- 21. To support economically disadvantaged students, the institution has implemented the initiative of "Save a Star". The institution also provides freebies to help students belonging to the economically weaker sections of the society.
- 22. Scholarships, proficiency and endowment prizes help students to stay motivated.
- 23. Community services are carried out by the college through the NSS. The Departments also provide classes and programmes that are beneficial to the community.

Department of Home Science




- The Department offers an aided undergraduate programme in Family and Community Science and an aided postgraduate programme in Community and Family Science. The six permanent and highly qualified faculty members actively involves themselves in the teaching-learning process.
- Out of the six permanent faculty members, two faculty members are PhD holders.
- The faculty members possess adequate publications and are actively involved in research activities.
- The faculty members are actively engaged in community education as resource persons and imparts valuable knowledge for the betterment of the community.
- The Department has applied for a Research Centre.
- The Department organises various programmes for the students to keep in pace with the recent developments and trends in the discipline of Home Science.
- Faculty members are involved in UGC funded minor research projects. UGC Sponsored National seminars are also conducted by the department.
- Students paper publications in national seminar proceedings is remarkable.

- Extension and extra-curricular programmes were conducted.
- Association activities are adequate and excellent.
- The results of PG and UG programmes were found to be good and students are
 often university rank holders which is suggestive of a commendable academic

Department of Physics




Observations

- The overall scores are good but more focus can be given to consultancy and extension areas.

- Students are given remedial coaching to improve their performance.
- Seminars with sponsorships were organized, by proper utilization of funds from agencies.
- Various activities were organized by the Physics association, which was focused on students.
- Excellent university results with rank is suggestive of the commendable academic performance of the Department.
- Students excelled in studies and progressed to higher studies.
- Certificate courses offered were relevant to meet the career needs of students.

Suggestions

Soft skill courses may be conducted for the students. Faculty should involve in publishing articles in reputed journals and motivate students to do the same. Faculty members can apply for minor research projects. A total improvement in the area of consultancy is needed. Extension activities for students may be encouraged. The Department must have active MoU's.

Observations


- The teaching and learning process was found to be effective.

enhancing their academic calibre. Students may be given orientation regarding career prospects and competitive exams.


Department of Zoology

Department of Commerce




- Student oriented teaching-learning activity is good. Faculty members regularly attend seminars.

Department of Economics




- Teaching-learning aspects were found to be good and Faculty members have attended subject related seminars.

Department of English (Self Financing)




Observations

PG Department of Physics (Self Financing)




Observations

PG Department of Chemistry (Self Financing)




Observations

PG Department of Zoology (Self Financing)




Observations


- The Department's pragmatic utilisation teaching-learning methods is much appreciated.

- Supportive activities for students were found to be good and effective.


Suggestions




The histogram shown below is findings by IQAC based on criterion- wise and department wise analysis


