General Observations

1. The institution is located in Nedumbassery gram panchayath area and the airport can

be accessed easily.

2. The institution celebrated Golden Jubilee year with variety of activities. College

stands with the crowning glory of A Grade in its third cycle of accreditation.

Institution planned its jubilee activities along with department wise jubilee

programmes.

3. Primary aim was to get sanction for research centre in Home Science, the department

was elevated to PG and Research department during December 2017. This was the 2nd

Research centre in Kerala.

4. College received the Consumer protection award for best college.


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- 5. NSS unit of the College received award of honour from Indian Medial Association and Regional blood bank for organising repeated blood donation camps. Also won the award for the university level performance of NSS unit.
- 6. Faculties received awards in different categories, appreciation for NSS programme officer, distinguished leader in Science and Honorary D.Litt.
- 7. The ambience of the institution is apt for the overall development of a student.
- 8. The Management, Principal, faculty members and students work in harmony by abiding to the rules and regulations of the institution.
- 9. Well-equipped classrooms and laboratories help in the proper functioning of the institution.
- 10. Faculty members are highly qualified and a considerable number of them have doctoral degrees.
- 11. The IQAC team designs the framework of the various academic, extra-curricular and extension activities of the institution and takes adequate steps to implement it appropriately.
- 12. An action plan is prepared for each year and is implemented with the help of the various Departments of the institution.
- 13. Excellent and highly qualified faculties were added to the College.

Department wise observations and suggestions

Department of Home Science




- All the faculty members in the Department are permanent which makes it advantageous for the Department.
- The teaching-learning methods were adequately utilized by the faculty.
- In addition to the continuous evaluations, the seminars and assignments helped students to achieve better results.
- Faculty members and students attended seminars and a majority of the faculty members were invited as resource persons for various academic programmes.
- Certificate course in fashion technology for students and "Grahadarshan" for senior secondary students are two programmes that attract students to the discipline of Home Science.
- Subject related programmes conducted by the Department includes Tipioka fest, financial literacy etc. The aforementioned programmes were useful in cultivating interest in the discipline of Home Science.
- Faculty members and students have an appreciable number of research publications.

- The Department's recognition as a research Centre will be a stepping stone for authentic research and innovation in the discipline of Home Science.
- Ample number of career guidance classes were offered by the Department.
- The Department can do a lot of extension activities based on its subjects. Several Classes and workshops were conducted.
- The students are actively involvement in curricular and extracurricular activities and several students have secured remarkable achievements in sports.
- Faculty members have received international awards and D. Litt, which evidently symbolises the professionalism of the faculty members.
- Cent percent result in the postgraduate programme and excellent results in the undergraduate programme are exemplary achievements. The students of the Department were also able to secure ranks at the UG and PG level.
- Students were also able to crack competitive exams.
- Student supportive services of the Department were found to be excellent.

The Department may apply for funding from different agencies. A remarkable achievement of the Department is the research centre in Home Science. This will enable the department to reach greater heights in higher education. The students are given continuous evaluation. The extension activities were found to be more effective. Department of Physics




- Teaching-learning was found to be better with regular conduct of constant evaluation.

Department of Chemistry




- The Department has highly qualified teachers with PhD.
- Most of the teaching-learning methods were adopted by the department. In addition to
 the existing methods, the Department has also utilised the methods of problem
 solving, participative learning and peer group learning.
- The teaching-learning process involves class assignments, group discussion, seminars, quiz etc.

- Feedback mechanism was found to be excellent and analysis of the same was done effectively.
- Faculty members actively participated in seminars, workshops and organized various programmes for the students.
- Observance of World Ozone Day and World Wetland Day suggests the enthusiasm of the Department towards sustainable development.
- To keep in pace with the recent developments in the discipline and for enhancing entrepreneurial skills, skill development programmes on soap making and turning waste into useful products were conducted by the Department.
- Faculty members provided opportunities to be aware of the developments in their respective fields.
- Virtual labs organized by the Department was found to be effective.
- Faculty members have published a considerable number of research articles and students have secured funding from KSCTE for their projects. The Department has adequate funding from external agencies for various programmes.
- Consultancy on soil analysis is a remarkable feature of the Department.
- Sufficient number of extension activities were organized by the Department for the financially disadvantaged sections of the community.
- Partnership with NGOs and other institutions were undertaken by the department.
- Students were encouraged to participate and organize extra-curricular activities.
- Academic performance was found to be excellent with a pass percentage of 96.4% and students securing 4th and 7th position in the university examination.

Department of Zoology




- The Department excelled in a majority of the criterions and faculty members regularly participated and conducted seminars.

Observations


- The teaching-learning activities were found to be efficient and produced excellent academic results.

Suggestions

The performance of the Department in academic, extra-curricular activities were outstanding. However, the faculty participation in seminars and research publications must be improved. Addition of permanent staff will help in the development of the Department. The Department should find out the funding agencies in their field and secure funding for research/ academic activities. Consultancy services related to the discipline can be initiated. Coaching can be provided by the Department for competitive exams. Campus placements can be initiated.

Department of Economics




- The teaching-learning process was found to be effective due to te\he proper utilization of different teaching methods.

- Faculty members were involved in the administrative and allied activities of the institution.



Department of English (Self Financing)

- Faculty attended and organized seminars related to their subject field and has published adequate number papers in reputed journals.
- The Department promotes soft skills through certificate courses like communicative skills in English, manuscript magazines and interdepartmental competitions.
- To keep in pace with the recent trends in language and literature, students were motivated to take part in intercollegiate workshops and "Cynosure" a manuscript published by the Department.
- The Department has done a commendable work in giving special care to students who were slow learners through special classes, peer learning, question paper solving etc.
- Sports and academic activities were found to be good.
- Extra-curricular activities of students were excellent.
- Certificate course on Business English is an added feature of the Department.
- Activity oriented classes by the faculty members helped to identify the barriers in personality development.

Consultancy and extension activities must be given more attention. Despite the self-financing status of the Department, regularity of staff can be ensured. The Department may seek funding to conduct seminars. Need to focus and conduct career guidance programmes for students. Extracurricular activities were found to be good. Students exceled in academics with a student from the initial batch securing position in the university examination. In spite of being the first batch the Department was able to secure good results.



PG Department of Physics (Self Financing)


Observations


- The overall performance of the Department seems just satisfactory.

needs more attention. Career guidance and counselling may be provided. Special attention should be given to the research, consultancy and extension.






Observations

Observations


- Computer aided learning and focus on continuous evaluation was observed in the Department.

- Entrepreneurial skills can be developed by creating more awareness classes and workshops.


Suggestions




Criterion wise distribution


The department-wise and criterion-wise scores of the analysis are depicted in the following histogram.


