In 1968, the college started an undergraduate course in Home Science, affiliated to Kerala University. Later, the college got affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University when the university was established. For decades, Morning Star Home Science College has been marching forward with significant progress in women education and has always shown readiness for innovation and diversification. With the aim of making women self-reliant, the college offered various vocational programmes for mothers of students and local women. The College attained 'A' grade after the NAAC Accreditation in the third cycle.
