
## **COLLEGE UNION REPORT: 2021-22**








#### TEACHERS DAY CELEBRATION

Talent's day was organized for first year and second year students on 18<sup>th</sup> November 2021. And Students were also given an opportunity to exhibit their handicraft works for the same.












## FAREWELL MEETING FOR MS. MARY V J
