Objective: The main objective was to celebrate onam and to enjoy our traditional culture.





On 2 November 2023 the college union organised a poster making competition for the students, on the theme 'KERALEEYAM'.


On 6 November 2023 the college union conducted a department wise Wall Magazine competition.

Outcome: This created opportunities for students to interact with their peers, form new friendships, and expand their social networks.



Objective: To provide an opportunity to students to showcase their creative talent in the field of art.




