






#### **BRIDGE COURSE AND APTITUDE TEST**




















#### WORKSHOP ON RESEARCH ARTICLE WRITING






## ORIENTATION PROGRAMME ON 'MGU UGP HONOURS FOR HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS'
